## TURN AWAY FROM SIN AND BE RECONCILED TO THE FATHER

The Ten Commandments and Jesus' Sermon on the Mount as a means to form and examine one's conscience

## 1. I, the Lord am your God. You shall not have other gods besides me.

## Sins against Faith:

- a. **Sacrilege** treating unworthily or with disrespect the sacraments and other liturgical actions, as well as persons, things, or places consecrated to God (A Very Serious Sin, especially when committed against the Eucharist)
- b. **Denying all or any of the truths** which God teaches through the Church.
- c. **Deliberate** doubt about any truth of faith
- d. Failure to profess the faith when obliged to do so
- e. Failure to obtain necessary religious instruction
- f. Reading books or using other materials that are dangerous to our faith
- g.  $\,$  Refusal to accept the authority of the pope as visible head of the Church
- h. Worship of some created thing instead of the true God (money, power, Satan)
- i. Superstition (Tarot cards, astrology, belief in good luck charms, fortune tellers)
- j. Participation in spiritualistic séances or the consultation of mediums
- k. Santeria, voodoo, etc.

### Sins against Hope:

- a. Presumption taking for granted that salvation can be obtained by one's own efforts without God OR
   by God's help without one's own cooperation
- b. **Despair** a refusal to trust that God will forgive our sins and give us what we need for salvation

## Sins against Love:

all sins are sins against love, but specifically the sins under the Fifth Commandment are sins against Love.

### 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord, your God, in vain.

- a. **Blasphemy** mocking, ridiculing, despising God, his Church, the saints, or holy objects ( A Very Serious Sin)
- b. Irreverence in using the name of God. Jesus or the saints
- c. Cursing calling down evil upon another person
- d. **Swearing** calling upon God to witness to the truth of what we are saying, when what we are saying is not true

or

when there is no sufficient reason to call upon God

e. **Breaking a vow** - a deliberate promise made to God to do something which is particularly pleasing to him

# 3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day.

### Sins against the 3rd Commandment

- 1. **Failing to attend Mass** on Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation (unless it is due to serious illness or conditions make it impossible)
- 2. Refusing to participate fully in Mass or other liturgies
- 3. Doing unnecessary work on Sunday
- 4. Failing to use adequate time for prayer and reflection on God's Word and will

## 4. Honor your father and your mother.

### Sins against the 4th Commandment

- 1. **Disobeying** parents, teachers, other adults who care for us
  - --talking back
  - --refusing or failing to do what they ask
  - --fooling around and disrupting class or other activities
- 2. Failing to respect and care for parents, particularly in their old age
- 3. Disobeying the Church
- 4. **Refusing to support the Church** through support of and involvement in parish life
- 5. **Disobeying lawful authorities** like police and government officials
- 6. **Neglecting our duties as citizens** of a country
  - --cheating on taxes
  - --refusing to serve in the military or other community service when required to

### 5. You shall not kill.

### RESPECT LIFE

### Sins against Life:

- 1. Murder
- 2. Abortion obtaining, assisting someone obtain or providing abortion
- 3. Mercy Killing / Euthanasia
- 4. Suicide5. Physical or emotional abuse of others, including spouse and children
- 6. Mutilation of one's body without a sufficient reason (tattoos, piercings, unnecessary plastic surgery)
- 7. Risking one's life without a sufficient reason, like careless driving or driving after drinking
- 8. Failure to care for one's Health Excessive eating or drinking, inadequate nutrition, poor diet, smoking,
- 9. Unjust anger, which leads to hatred, revenge, fighting, and quarreling
- 10. Abuse of the body and mind by drugs and alcohol

### 6. You shall not commit adultery.

# RESPECT SEXUALITY

9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.

# The Gift of Sexual Love

Purpose:	1. To Express the Deep Love & Union of Spouses
	2. To Create New Life

The ONLY proper Use is in the Union of Marriage between Husband & Wife

## Sins against the Gift of Sex

- 1. Adultery sexual relations by a married person with someone other than their spouse
- 2. Fornication sexual relations by 2 people who are not united by God in marriage. Catholics only marry by receiving the Sacrament of Marriage
- 3. Prostitution
- 4. Rape seriously wrong for it violates the dignity of another by force
- 5. Sexual abuse of children
- 6. Pornography
- 7. Homosexual Acts the behaviors, not the orientation is sinful
- 8. Use of Artificial Contraception this closes the person to openness to new life being created
- 9. Sterilization (when chosen to avoid conceiving a child) -vasectomy, tubal ligation, etc.
- 10. Masturbation -turns a gift of self-giving to a spouse into a self-centered act
- 11. Lustful Fantasy and Imagination

#### 7. You shall not steal

## RESPECT PROPERTY

### 10. You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor

## **Sins against Property**

- 1. Stealing
- 2. Accepting stolen goods
- 3. Cheating
- 4. Vandalism
- 5. Accepting bribes
- 6. Using false weights, measures, or descriptions in commerce
- 7. Charging very high prices
- 8. Wasting time, especially at one's job
- 9. Careless work
- 10. Breaking contracts or agreements
- 11. Envy of another's possessions

### 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

RESPECT THE TRUTH

### Sins against the Truth

- 1. Perjury lying under oath
- 2. Lying speaking falsehoods
- 3. Calumny Damaging another's reputation by lying
- **4. Detraction** revealing another's faults without good reason
- 5. Gossip
- 6. Rash judgment assuming the worst about another
- 7. Revealing certain secrets
